


Do's and Don'ts of Medical Cannabis Use




DO




Get certified for medical cannabis use by registered practitioner.
A written certification is needed before you go to a dispensary.

Bring a valid government-issued ID to the dispensary.




Types of valid IDs include a passport or government-issued driver's license.



Pre-register with the dispensaries at which you plan to shop.
This will reduce wait times.

Renew your medical cannabis certification each year.



Written certifications for medical cannabis are only valid one year



DON'T




Use cannabis in public.
Using cannabis in public is illegal in Virginia.

Use cannabis and drive.




It is illegal and unsafe to drive under the influence in Virginia.



Use more cannabis than recommended.
Follow practitioner, pharmacist, and serving size recommendations.

Sell your cannabis supply to someone else.



It is illegal for individuals to sell cannabis products in Virginia.
